Fukuoka Prize (Fukuoka Asian Culture Prize) was established in 1990 through the collaboration between academia, businesses, and the city authorities to honor outstanding achievements by individuals or groups/organizations in preserving and creating the unique and diverse culture of Asia. This year marks the 23 rd anniversary and there have been 88 prize recipients from almost every region of Asia in the last 22 years. We invited the three laureates from Philippines in the past; Mr. Leandro V. Locsin in 1992, Ms. Marilou Diaz-Abaya in 2001, and Prof. Reynaldo C. Ileto in 2003. The aim is to foster and increase awareness of the value of Asian cultures as well as to establish a framework within which Asian can learn from, and share with, each other. The Award Ceremony and related official events are held every September in Fukuoka.
